What's Happening in Faith Quest

Preschoolers-Kindergarteners

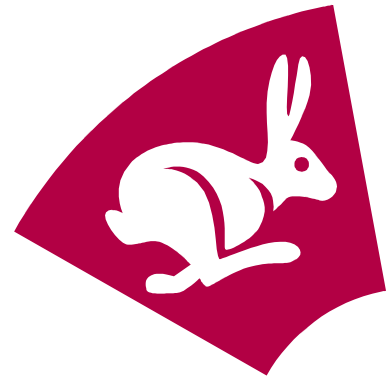
The preschool/Kindergarten classroom will begin a new Hands On Bible Curriculum module about Jesus' Last Days. This module is designed to help children understand Jesus' compassion and willingness to suffer for our sakes. They will learn through the use of games, crafts, music, and stories. Watch each week for a take home sheet that tells you what they learned and gives you some ideas of questions to ask so that you may continue the conversation at home.

First-Fifth Grade

We are going to do a unit called Doubting Thomas this month in Faith Quest. The children will learn that even the disciples had doubts but that all doubt disappeared with the proof of the resurrection. The kids will play a game using their five senses. Next they will do a science lab where they make pictures that have Jesus disappear and reappear. They will act out a skit showing what would happen if people saw Jesus alive today. Finally we will make a starter for bread that they will take home.

Confirmation

This month we will begin a new curriculum, FaithWeaver. March will have us studying Jesus' teachings about good fruit, the parable of the lost son, and washing the disciple's feet. We will end the unit with a discussion of His trial and crucifixion.

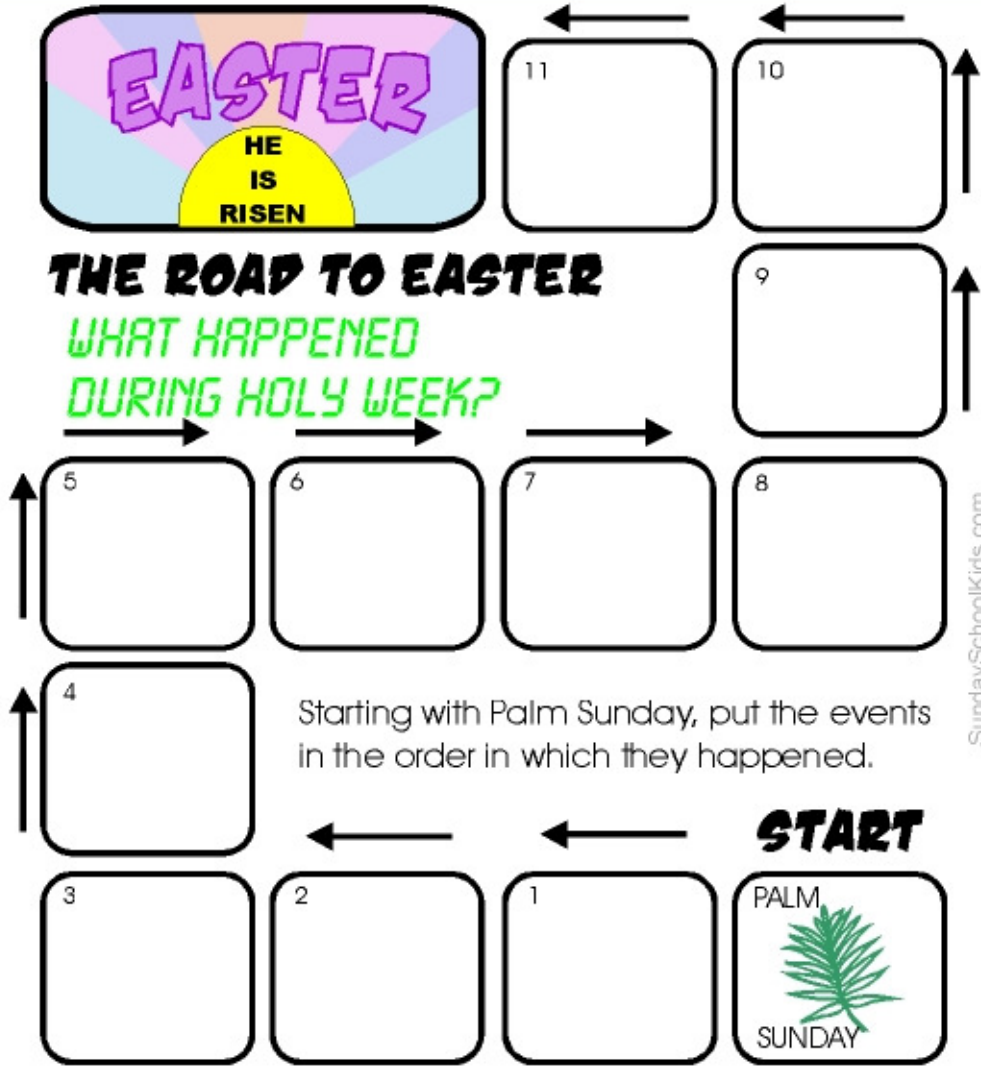
HELP IS NEEDED

WHAT HAPPENED DURING HOLY WEEK?




